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**NEXT GENERATION OF EMPLOYEE INTERNET MANAGEMENT
LETS WORKERS MANAGE THEMSELVES**

When employees begin to violate the Internet use policy, the employee interface notifies them and their manager. Employees can go about their job and use the Internet without the fear that their manager is constantly watching them. At the same time, managers can focus on their own jobs and deal only with problem cases.

“We knew we needed to get a better handle on our employees’ Internet use while at work, but we didn’t want to compromise the trust in our corporate culture. That’s why we decided to go with FastTracker,” said Tom Progrin, general manager of Landmark Audiobooks. “With the FastTracker service, employees always know where they stand. There are no surprises, and managers don’t have to constantly police employees. It’s really the best possible solution when it comes to effective Employee Internet Management.”
